



Lemuel Dwight Riggleman

August 23, 1937 - January 17, 2010

Lemuel Dwight Riggleman passed away January 17, 2009 at Caroline Nursing and Rehabilitation Center, surrounded by his loving family. He was 72 years old.

Born August 23, 1937 in Monterville, WV, he was the son of the late, Isaac French Riggleman and Emma Pingley Riggleman. Dwight graduated from Tygarts Valley High School in 1955.

He was in the Army National Guard from 1954 to 1956 and received a honorary discharge in 1962. After high school he worked in Cleveland, Ohio at Thomas Products until October 1957. He went back to Elkins, WV and worked at Farm Fresh Dairy. In 1959, Dwight and his wife moved to Alexandria, VA where he worked at Alexandria Dairy. After eight and a half years there, the family moved to Wye Mills, MD. There he went to work for Esskay Feeder Lot and later at Wye Plantation, managing the famous Wye Angus Cattle herd, retiring in 1989 after 21 years. Dwight and his wife owned and operated Wye Mills Market from 1975 until 2008. He was a charter member of the Bay Country Moose Lodge.

Dwight leaves to cherish his memory, his wife, the former Carol Sue Bohan, who he married on July 27, 1957 Elkins, WV; three daughters, Rhonda Alexander Corder and her husband, John, Donna Pletzer and her husband, Paul, all of Wye Mills, MD and Carla Stevenson and her husband, Chris of

Cordova, MD and five grandchildren, who always brightened his days, Angela Alexander, Zachary and Jacob Pletzer, and Mackenzie and Gwendolyn Stevenson.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a son, Ronald Dwayne, four brothers, John, Sherman, Eugene and Osbert Riggelman and two sisters, Elsie Starcher and Mary Jo Bohan.

A visitation will be held on Wednesday, January 20, 2010 from 6 to 8pm at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 408 South Liberty Street, Centreville, MD. A funeral service will be held at 11am on Thursday, January 21, 2010 at the funeral home. Interment will follow at Chesterfield Cemetery.
