



Leoma Bowser Stahl

May 15, 1932 - October 12, 2018

Leoma Bowser Stahl of Stevensville, MD, passed away peacefully on October 12, 2018, at Corsica Hills Nursing Home. She was 86.

Born in Baltimore, MD, on May 15, 1932, she was the daughter of Chester Leland Bowser and Della Sylvia Lingan. She graduated from Western High School in the Class of 1949. On November 14, 1953, she married Louis L. Stahl of Baltimore. Mrs. Stahl began working as a secretary at the News American Newspaper. She later worked for the B&O Railroad, where she started as a secretary and worked her way up to Assistant Purchasing Agent, a position from which she retired in 1961.

Mrs. Stahl served as a Worthy Matron of the Martha Chapter #30 of the Order of the Eastern Star in Baltimore, MD. She was also a member of the Kent Island American Legion #278 Ladies Auxiliary, the Kent Island United Methodist Church, and the Greensboro United Methodist Church.

She is survived by her son, Barry Lee Stahl, his wife Kimberly, and granddaughter, Amanda Stahl. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Louis Stahl, and grandson, Daniel Stahl.

will start at 10 a.m. Burial will follow the service in Meadowridge Memorial Park in Elkridge, MD.
