Leonard William Carter, 74, of McDaniel, MD died on Thursday, December 18, 2025, at UMSMC at Easton, MD.

He was born to Stephen and Florence Carter on November 16, 1951, in Albany, New York. Later, they moved to Massachusetts where he completed his education. In 1976, he entered the United States Army, which took him to El Paso, Texas, Anchorage, Alaska, and Hawaii.
