



Leonard H. Foulds III

July 5, 1934 - December 5, 2014

Leonard Hodgson Foulds III (Leo), 80, of St. Michaels, MD, died at home on hospice care. Born July 5, 1934, in Stockport, Cheshire, England, he was the son of James Whalley Foulds and Christine Green Foulds.

After graduating from High School in Neath, South Wales, he volunteered for military service in the British Army Second Dragoon Guards and later transferred to the Royal Army Ordnance Corp to be trained in their elite Bomb Disposal Unit. As senior NC, he served from 1953-1957. He was awarded a British Steel Scholarship to attend the School of Architecture at the University of Wales, Cardiff and after three years of design discipline, he joined Proctor & Gamble sales team. This was his stepping stone in sales and marketing with a leading corporation, and it located him to London, Hamburg, New York, San Francisco and Los Angeles.

After moving to the Eastern Shore of Maryland, he continued as a supermarket sales and marketing consultant for Alpo and Heinz Pet Foods. He was known for his humor and whenever a group of people gathered, if Leo was present there was laughter.

Mr. Foulds studied classical music, wrote poetry, painted watercolors, enjoyed animals both domestic and wild; he was always close to nature. He was a man of many facets.

He supported groups of Disabled American Veterans, Native American Heritage Foundation, and the Honorable Order of Kentucky Colonels.

In local organizations, he was a two-year president of the St. Andrews Society of the Eastern Shore of Maryland, chairman of the Men's Group at Christ Episcopal Church St. Michaels, and a board member of the Miles River Yacht Club.

In 1999, Leo married Elizabeth Y. Grant. In addition to his beloved wife, Leo is survived by his daughter Ellen Tanja Foulds of HI; his son, Jason Warwick (Margaret) Foulds of NH; two grandchildren, Leo and Shannon; the mother of his children, Marion Shaw; and stepson, David A. Grant. Leo was predeceased by his parents, Christine and James.

A memorial service will be held at Christ Church St. Michaels on Saturday, December 20, 2014, at noon.
