Leonard “Lenny” Eugene Frye of Chester, MD, passed away on December 12, 2017, at his home. He was 91.

Born on October 1, 1926, in Frederick, MD, the son of the late “Trukey” Frye and Dorothy Smith. He grew up in Lovettsville, VA ,and graduated from Lovettsville High School. Lenny served in the Army during the Korean War and was discharged as a Corporal. He would go on to build his home on Kent Island in Stevensville, MD, in the late 1970’s.

Lenny worked for B&O railroad and later for Eastern Airlines retiring in the 1980’s. His wife, Doris Smith Frye, passed away in April 1998. Lenny loved the Ravens, the Colts, and the Orioles. He was a member of Kent Island United Methodist Church.

Lenny is survived by his granddaughter, Erica L. Frye; daughter-in-law, Brenda Frye; two sisters, Barbara Glutner, Georgia Ridgeway; and longtime caregiver, Carol Reinking In addition to his wife, Doris, he was predeceased by his other six siblings and his son, Barry Frye.

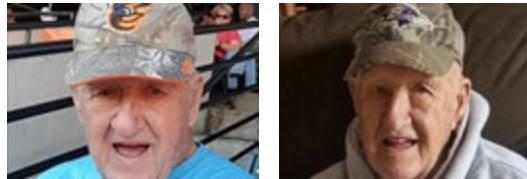
