



Leonard I. Nichols

May 2, 1932 - November 28, 2008

Leonard I. Nichols of Easton, MD, formerly of Arnold, died on Friday, November 28, 2008 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 76.

Born May 2, 1932 in Winchester, Mass, he was the son of the late Leonard and Alberta O'Brien Nichols. During his childhood, he was raised in Reading, Mass. He then attended U.S. Dependent High School in Germany and Austria in 1946. In 1950 he graduated and returned to the U.S., residing in San Antonio, TX. He moved to Washington, D.C. in 1951 where he began his college education and R.O.T.C. training at Georgetown University. After graduation in 1955 he was commissioned into the U.S. Air Force, serving in Korea. After being honorably discharged in 1958, he served in the reserves where he earned the rank of Captain. He then began working as a welfare and pension plan consultant. In 1962 he began his career for the Federal Government working for the Department of Labor in the Labor-Management Services Administration, where he remained until retiring in 1982.

On May 5, 1979 he married the former Sally Anne Linn of Potomac, MD. They resided in Arnold, MD until moving to Easton, on the Eastern Shore, in 2000.

A member of the National Active and Retired Federal Employees Association, Tidewater Chapter (N.A.R.F.E.), he also enjoyed cars, golf, sailing, reading, collecting model cars, and old movies.

In addition to his wife, Sally Anne Nichols, Mr. Nichols is survived by his stepdaughter, Elizabeth Anne Linn of Columbus, OH; and a brother, John A. Nichols and his wife Valerie of Annapolis, MD.
