



Leonard Robert Wendling

March 28, 1935 - November 1, 2010

Bob Wendling of Stevensville, MD died Monday November 1, 2010 at Memorial Hospital in Easton, MD. He was 75.

Bob was born on March 28, 1935 in Atlantic City, NJ the son of the late Leonard Wilson Wendling and Josephine Theresa Kiselewski. Bob grew up in Arlington, VA and was a graduate of Washington & Lee High School class of 1954. After high school he enlisted and served in the Air Force from 1954 to 1958 in Amarillo, TX as an aircraft mechanic. He was honorably discharged he attended college at the North Texas State University and the Capital Radio Institute. In 1960 Bob moved back to Virginia and began his career as an electronics component engineer, representing 17 major electronic companies throughout the United States. In 1978 he would establish, own and operate, Dulles Office Furniture, Inc. in Northern, VA retiring in 2004.

Bob was an avid boater who would make his residence on his beloved Maryland's Eastern Shore on Kent Island. Boating in the spring and summers and he enjoyed his winters as a "snowbird" in St. James City, FL. He was a certified auctioneer from the Mendenhall Auctioneer School, who loved jazz music and was the youngest member of the Eastern Power Boat Club in Washington D.C., a member of the Kent Island Yacht Club, the youngest member to join the Capital Yacht Club, a member of the American Legion, Moose, and the Elks.

He is survived by his loving partner, Charlotte Fletcher of Stevensville, MD; a daughter, Lora McLain and her husband Clifford of Fairfax, VA; Charlotte's two sons, John Fletcher and his wife Suzanne of Tampa, FL and Michael Fletcher and his wife Jane of Ashburn, VA; a sister, Sandra Hicks and her husband Ronald of Dayton, OH; Nine grandchildren, Cindy, Erica, Clifford, Cheryl, Caleigh, Caden, Charlie, Sam and Jack. He was predeceased by a daughter, Lisa Hamill (2003) and his brother Ronald Wendling.

Services will be held on December 29, 2010, 3:00PM at Fort Myer Chapel, Arlington National Cemetery. A reception will be held at the Officer's Club following the services.
