Leo Wesley Lathroum of Queenstown, MD died at the Memorial Hospital, Easton, MD on Monday, December 23, 2002. He was 77.

Born May 24, 1925 in Baltimore, he was the son of the late Irving and Mildred Lehmen Lathroum. He graduated from the McDonough School in 1943 and attended Dickinson College before entering the Navy's V-12 Program. The Navy sent him to Northwestern University and Franklin and Marshall College. He served as an Ensign on a destroyer during the occupation of Japan in World War II. Following his release from active duty he returned to Franklin and Marshall College where he earned his B.S. in mathematics in 1947. He became a graduate assistant in the Math Dept at the University of Maryland where he met his wife, Harriet Jane Davis. They were married on July 3, 1948. He worked in research and development at National Security Agency for 30 years until his retirement in 1980.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Lathroum leaves three children, Barbara Lathroum of Downingtown, PA, Bob Lathroum of Denton, MD and Bill Lathroum of Arnold, MD; 6 grandchildren and 3 great grandchildren.

He and his wife lived in Queenstown for 30 years. He was active in square dancing on the Eastern Shore for many years.
