LeRoy Franklin Scott, Sr., of Chester, MD, died Friday, September 27, 2002 at Heart Homes of Piney Orchard, Odenton, MD. He was 83.

Born in Miller, IA, on December 3, 1918, he was the son of the late Franklin H. and Gena J. Ingebritson Scott. He moved to Washington, DC, at the age of 14 and later attended the University of Maryland at College Park. As a young man, he studied music. During World War II, he served in the U.S. Navy as 2nd class Petty Officer in the Navy Band. After the war, Mr. Scott played music on the East Coast for many celebrities.

He was a member of the Kent Island American Legion Post #278 in Stevensville, MD.

Mr. Scott is survived by three sons, Douglas F. Scott, Gerald L. Scott, and LeRoy F. Scott, Jr.; a daughter, Donna Amy Saia; six grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at 1:45 PM on Monday, September 30, 2002, at the Chapel at Maryland Veterans Cemetery, Crownsville, MD.
