



Leroy Kenneth Hurley Sr.

April 30, 1932 - December 17, 2024

Leroy Kenneth Hurley Sr., of Easton, died on December 17th, 2024, at Candlelight Cove. He was 92.

Born in Cambridge, April 30, 1932, he was the one of the late William Luther, Sr. and Missile Olive Todd Hurley. After graduating from Cambridge High School in 1951, he worked briefly for the Cambridge Wire Cloth Company before joining the U.S. Army in August of 1952. He served in Korea during this enlistment. Following his release from active duty in August of 1955, he transferred to the U.S. Army Reserve where he served until retiring in August of 1987 with the rank of Command Sergeant Major.

As a civilian, he worked for the C & P Telephone Company, then Bell Atlantic from 1956 until retiring in April of 1992 as a Central Office Technician with 36 years of service.

A resident of Easton since 1977, he did volunteer work as a mentor in Talbot, Dorchester and Caroline Counties for troubled youth and was active in youth baseball with the Little Leagues, High School, and American Legion Baseball programs for 40 years. His memberships included the Dorchester Post 91, American Legion in Cambridge, the National Association of Non-Commissioned Officers, the Telephone Pioneers of America and the AARP. In his spare time, he enjoyed traveling in the United States.

Mr. Hurley is preceded in death by 8 brothers and 2 sisters.

Mr. Hurley is survived by his wife, the former Jacquelyn M. Dulin, whom he married in Carmichael, Md on October 22, 1977; two daughters, Leslie J. Bailey of Richmond, VA and Norma Jo Dowling of Littleton, PA; a son, Leroy K. Hurley Jr. of Gerrardstown, WV; eleven grandchildren; and 3 great grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on December 28th, 2024, at 1 PM at the Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home P.A., Easton. The burial with full military honors will be at New Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton.
