Leroy Edward Sayler left this world “his way” on Saturday, July 17, 2021, at 70 years old.

Born May 7, 1951 in Frederick, MD, he was the son of the late Carroll Edward Sayler and Mildred Moran Thorpe.

He graduated from Seaford High School in 1969 and served proudly in the National Guard. He retired in 2015 after several decades as a Master Electrician at the Aqua Pool Company in Easton, MD.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sisters, Peggy Fischer and Elaine Flanary.

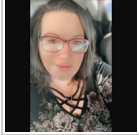
