August 30, 1947 - December 5, 2022

LeRoy (“Lee”) Van Emburgh, III, passed away on December 5, 2022, at the age of 75.

Lee was born in Camden, NJ, on August 30, 1947, the son of the late LeRoy and Sara Ann Van Emburgh. He graduated from Palmyra High School in 1966. Soon after graduation, Lee joined the U.S. Marine Corps and served in Vietnam. After the Marine Corps, Lee worked for the telephone company for 40 years both in New Jersey and in Florida.

Lee met the love his life, Susie, when he was 11 years old. They started dating when he was 16, and married on October 14, 1967. They recently celebrated their 55th wedding anniversary with a trip to Williamsburg, VA, one of their favorite places. They moved to Easton, MD, in September 2020.

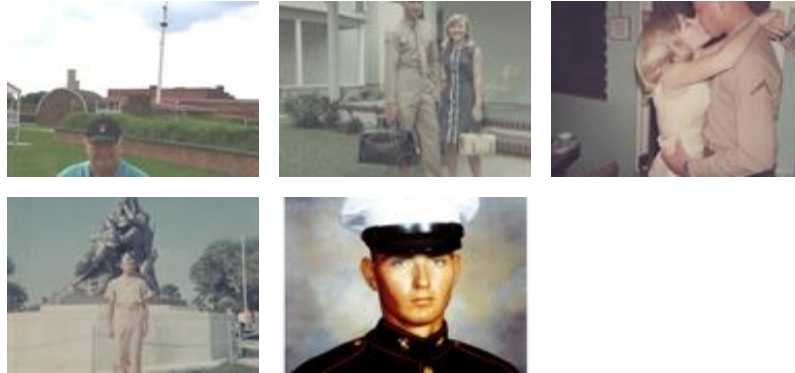
