



Lester William Fischer

March 19, 1929 - November 15, 2008

Lester William Fischer died peacefully at his home on Saturday, November 15, 2008. He was 79 years old.

Mr. Fischer was born on March 19, 1929 to the late Frederick Earnest Fischer and Elsa Gumbrick in Baltimore, MD. As soon as he was old enough he enlisted in the Army, serving during WWII. After being honorably discharged, he returned to Baltimore where he worked as a mechanic and operator for Arco on Washington Boulevard before retiring and driving a car carrier for Anchor Motor Freight out of Jessup, from which he retired in the mid 1980s. In 1975 he moved to Chester, MD where he would captain local charter fishing boats, "Fisch Hawk" He was a life-long member of the Severn River Beagle Club.

He was an avid fisherman and hunter and loved raising champion beagles. Mr. Fischer was a skilled craftsman who enjoyed making doll houses, fishing rods, and fishing lures.

Mr. Fischer is survived by his son, Alan Fischer of Queenstown, MD; 2 daughters, Brenda Fischer of Queenstown, MD and Leslie Kinsley and her husband Jeff of Church Hill, MD; 2 brothers, Carl Fischer, Sr. of Linthicum, MD and Elmer Fischer of Baltimore, MD; and 2 grandchildren, Julie and Calvin Kinsley.

A visitation will be held on Tuesday, November 18, 2008 from 2 to 4 pm and 6 to 8 pm at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, 106 Shamrock Road, Chester, MD where a funeral service will be held on Wednesday, November 19, 2008 at 11 AM. Interment will follow at Stevensville Cemetery.
