March 17, 1936 - January 19, 2015

Levi Calbert Gilliam of Church Hill, MD, died on Monday, January 19, 2015, at University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Chestertown. He was 78.

Born on March 17, 1936. in Bath, ME, he was the son of the late Hollis and Flora Gilliam. He was a lobsterman for many years, fishing in South Harpswell, ME.

On August 26, 1978, he married Marcia Minyo Gilliam. They started a family, living in Harpswell, ME, until moving to the Eastern Shore in 1995.
