



## Lewis Gillin

Lewis Thomas Gillin died on May 12, 2003 at Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center in Baltimore, MD. He was 86.

He was born on July 17, 1916 in Syracuse, NY, he was the youngest of five children born to the late Mary Hogan Gillin and Lewis Sanford Gillin. He was educated in New York and was a member of the 32nd Bomb Group, serving in the U.S. Army Air Corps as a flight engineer and a top turret gunner on a B25 in the South Pacific during World War II where he flew fifty missions and was awarded the Flight Medal for his service. Following his release from active duty he returned to New York City where he worked in the garment industry. He retired in 1983, and took up a post-retirement job with Citibank.

In 1997 he and his wife, Marie, moved to Chestertown, MD where he was a member of Sacred Heart Parish in Chestertown. He also enjoyed golf, building model airplanes, and a good joke.

In addition to his wife of 60 years, Marie E. O'Connell Gillin, he is survived by a son, Richard Gillin of Chestertown, MD; a daughter, Linda Gillin of Englewood, NJ; two grandchildren, Erin and Courtney Gillin, both of Chestertown, MD. He was predeceased by a daughter, Carolyn Rzeczkowski.
