



## Lewis H. Outten Sr.

October 12, 1931 - November 9, 2016

Lewis Henry Outten, Sr., 85, peacefully passed away on Wednesday, November 9, 2016, at Genesis, The Pines.

He was born in Easton, MD, on October 12, 1931, to Jesse Louis Outten and Elsie Mae Covey Outten. He attended Trappe School. At the age of 17, in July of 1949, he entered the United States Army. He was stationed in Alaska where he became a 1st Class Military Ski Instructor. In December, 1952, he was Honorably Discharged and returned to Easton, working various jobs until he met and worked for C. Albert Matthews, Inc. He worked there until he opened his own business in 1976, Lewis H. Outten, Inc.

In February of 1956, he married Shirley Mae Campbell. Through the years, they raised four children, traveled, and always had a "project" that they were working on. He loved family, life, and the Orioles. He is survived by daughters, Sylvia Swann (Bob) of Trappe, Sandy Chance (Marty) of Easton; sons, Lewis H. (Luke) Outten, Jr. (Sandy) of Trappe and L. H. Outten, Trappe; sisters, Catherine Quidas of Preston, Emma Fisher of Easton and a brother, Harvey Ross of Paris, TN.

Besides his parents, he is preceded in death by his wife Shirley; and sisters, Alice Foster and Charlotte Hause.

He leaves behind nine grandchildren and ten great grandchildren.
