Lewis H. O'Byrne of Denton died at the Shore Nursing and Rehab Center on Friday, October 12, 2001. He was 81.

Born on February 1, 1920 in Allegheny Co. Pennsylvania, he was the son of the late Edmund H. and Nan Allen O'Byrne. After graduating from West View high school in West View, PA. in 1938 he attended Pennsylvania State University where he received a degree in Forestry in 1942. During WWII he served in the U.S. Army where he fought in the African Middle Eastern Battle, Italy, France and Germany. He received four battle stars, one Bronze Arrowhead, a Silver Star and a Purple Heart for his bravery and valor. Following his release from active duty in 1946 he worked for the Commonwealth of PA, until his retirement in 1978. He then moved to Venice, Florida where he enjoyed golfing, bowling & traveling. In April, 2000 he moved to Hyde Park, Easton.

Mr. O'Byrne is survived by his wife the former Beulah Sharp whom he married on November 27, 1952 and a daughter, Nancy O. Smith and her husband Russell of Annapolis and Denton MD.; one grandson Frank Fleming of Annapolis; and 2 great-grandchildren, Mollie Rose Fleming of Spring Hill, Florida and Caitlin Fleming of Annapolis; a sister-in-law, Verna Guzel and her husband Frank, of Caconsburg, PA and several nieces and nephews.
