Lila C. Kirkpatrick 1905-2006

Grasonville – Lila Clara Kirkpatrick of Grasonville died October 15, 2006 at home of natural causes. She was 101.

Lila C. Adams was born May 04, 1905 at home in Chicago, Illinois the daughter of the late Ethel and John Adams. Lila has been a member of the Baha'i Faith since 1943. Lila grew up in New Jersey and the New York city area. She moved to California in 1945 and lived there with her husbands and cousin for 50 years. She lived in a number of areas in and around Los Angeles as a homefront pioneer for the Bahá'í Faith. In 1995 she moved to Ohio to live near and then with her youngest daughter. In 2002 she moved to Grasonville, again as a homefront pioneer for the Bahá'í Faith to live with her granddaughter and her husband, Jennifer & Daniel Illari, where she was actively involved in the Queen Anne's County Bahá'í community. In 2005 at the age of 100, she fulfilled a lifelong dream to make a pilgrimage to Bahá'í Holy places in and around Haifa, Israel, which is the World Center of the Bahá'í Faith. She loved to read and was a regular at the local libraries.

She was preceded in death by both her husbands Melvin M. Hope, Sr. and Harlow B. Kirkpatrick. She is survived by her three children Faith Miller and Melvin M. Hope, Jr. of California, and Carol Pensinger of Ohio; seven

grandchildren and ten great grandchildren.

A Bahá'í funeral service will be held at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, Chester on Monday October 16, 2006 at 3:00PM. Interment will be at the Stevensville Cemetery.
