



Lilian Ruth Hopkins Linduska

November 25, 1914 - November 20, 2012

Lilian Hopkins Linduska of Chestertown, MD, died Tuesday, November 20, 2012, at the Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, MD. She was 97.

Lilian Hopkins Linduska was born November 25, 1914, in Polson, MT, the daughter of the late William L. Hopkins and Ruth "Godfrey" Hopkins. Mrs. Linduska graduated from the University of Montana and was then married to the late Dr. Joseph P. Linduska in 1936. She and her husband lived in numerous places across the United States and in 1956, moved to Chestertown, MD, and resided on the Eastern Shore for the more than 50 years.

Mrs. Linduska worked as a biologist for a short time but spent the majority of her life as a homemaker raising her family and donating her time to volunteer work. She was a charter member of the Yarmouth Questers; she volunteered at the Blood Bank; gray lady at Kent-Queen Anne's Hospital; and was a member of the Kent County Historical Society where she served as a docent at the Geddes-Piper House. She also served as docent at the Octagon House in Washington, DC. In addition, she was secretary for the Wildlife Society and a member of St. Paul's Parish Kent in Chestertown, MD.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Dr. Joseph P. Linduska, and one brother, William L. Hopkins.

She is survived by a daughter, Joanne Price of Lewes, DE; a son, Dr. James Linduska (Barbara) of Salisbury, MD; two grandchildren, Kent Price (Mary Elizabeth) of Greensboro, NC, and Cheryl Nelson (Michael) of Rehobeth Beach, DE; and two great-grandchildren, Clayton Nelson and Chase Nelson.

A memorial service will be held Saturday, November 24, 2012, at 10am, at Wesley Hall in Heron Point, Chestertown, MD.
