Lillian Mae Wright Burns passed away on Monday, November 3, 2014, at Heartland House in Grasonville, MD. She was 97.

She was born on June 18, 1917, in Frostburg, MD, and graduated in 1935 from Beall High School in Frostburg. In June of 1935, she married Calvin Burns and moved to Grasonville, MD. During her working career, she had various jobs, retiring in 1986 from the State of Maryland Comptroller's Office.

Mrs. Burns was an active member of Calvary United Methodist Church, serving as church treasurer for 23 years.

Lillian was preceded in death by her husband, Calvin Burns.
