Lillian Comegys Moore died at the Memorial Hospital, Easton, MD on Tuesday, July 27, 2010. She was 79.

Born in Centreville, MD on September 17, 1930, she was the youngest child of Herman and Lillian Comegys. She graduated from Centreville High School in 1948. She worked for Queenstown Medical Group for five years prior to her marriage on April 28, 1956 to Rev. Clarence P. Moore. In 2006 they celebrated their 50th anniversary.
