Lillian E. Haddaway of Claiborne, MD died on Monday July 22, 2002 at Talbot Hospice House in Easton, MD, where she had resided for ten months. She was 94.

Born in Baltimore, March 29, 1908, she was the daughter of the late Ferdinand and Catherine Moravec Euler. After graduating from Eastern High School in 1927, she worked as a secretary for the John E. Hurst Co., a dry goods supplier for medical institutions, until her marriage in Baltimore in December of 1931, to Edward Seth Haddaway, a Maryland State Policeman. They made their home at several duty stations in Maryland before building a home in Towson. Following his retirement, they moved to Claiborne in 1964 where he died in 1969.

A member of the St. Michaels Catholic Chapel and the St. Anne and Joachim Society of the church, she was also a member of the Bozman Homemakers.

Mrs. Haddaway is survived by a son, John D. Haddaway and his wife, Billie of Claiborne, MD; a brother, Charles F. Euler of SC and two granddaughters.

A Mass for the Dead will be celebrated at the St. Michaels Catholic Chapel, St. Michaels, MD on Friday July 26, 2002 at 10:00 AM.

Burial will be at Druid Ridge Cemetery, Baltimore, MD.
