



## Lillian S. Baynard

Lillian S. Baynard of Easton, MD died on Tuesday, December 20, 2005 at Genesis Eldercare-The Pines, Easton. She was 91.

Born June 10, 1914 in Ben Avon, PA, she was the daughter of the late Max C. and Lillian A. Sherman. Mrs. Baynard moved from Cynwood, PA with her family to Bennett Point Farms in Queenstown in 1926. After graduating from Centreville High School in 1932, she attended the University of Maryland School of Nursing, for one year. A life threatening illness prevented her from returning to the University. On October 27, 1934 she married her high school sweetheart, Risdon E. Baynard of Centreville.

In the 1940's and 50's Mrs. Baynard was a member of the Queenstown Homemakers Club and was active with the American Red Cross. In 1963 she and her family moved to the Baynard family farm on Starr Road in Centreville where she and Risdon farmed until his death in 1975 after 41 years of marriage. In 1977 she moved to Easton, MD where she volunteered her time to teach in a literacy program.

Mrs. Baynard, a beloved mother, is survived by three children, Joanne Baynard of Easton, Jean Webb and her husband Ralph of Chester, and Sherman Baynard and his wife Diane of Centreville; a brother, Mac C. Sherman, Jr. and his wife Libby of Chestertown; a niece, Martha Baynard of

Dover, DE; seven grandchildren and ten great grandchildren. She was predeceased by four sisters, Elisabeth Blake, Martha Sherman, Frances Nides and Jean Anthes.

A memorial service will be held on Tuesday, January 3, 2006 at 2:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., Centreville, MD.
