September 9, 1940 - September 1, 2009

Lilly Gloria Asbury, of Pasadena, MD, passed away Tuesday, September 1, 2009 at Baltimore Washington Medical Center. She was 68.

Lilly was born on September 9, 1940 in Bud, West Virginia to the late Earl Beecher Orender and Rena Oretta Meadows. She married Ralph Asbury on July 8, 1957 in West Virginia where they made their home until they moved to Annapolis, Maryland in 1964.
