



## Lily May Bauer

Lily May Bauer, of Easton, died at the Wm. Hill Health Care Center, Easton, on Friday, September 27, 2002. She was 90.

Born in Baltimore County, October 16, 1911, she was the daughter of the late Thomas, Sr. and Rosella Warnes Hankinson. After graduating from Rosedale High School and Strayer Business College, she worked as Office Manager and Personal Secretary to the Vice President of Standard Oil. After her marriage on October 20, 1932 to John G. Bauer, they purchased a farm in Bradshaw, MD where they lived until World War II, when they moved to Baltimore where she worked at Bethlehem Steel Corporation in the accounting dept. They moved back to the farm in 1946.

They started a business known as Balto Farms, Inc., which specialized in growing and the distribution of spinach and other vegetables nationwide. In addition, they had a roadside business they started in 1957. The stand, known as "The Farm" became well-known throughout the area and is still in existence today. It had been a regular feature on the TV show, Evening Magazine.

During their lifetime, they had purchased two farms and restored two historic homes.

They retired to Easton in 1986 where Mr. Bauer died Jan. 30, 1988.

Mrs. Bauer is survived by two daughters, Norma V. Huber and her husband, Wilfred, of Trappe and Gloria M. Davis and her husband, Lawrence, of Easton; two grandchildren, Michelle Beck and her husband, Cdr. Robert Beck, USN of Virginia Beach, VA and Sharon Brogan and her husband, Dr. David C. Brogan of Charlottesville, VA and a great-granddaughter, Rachel Beck.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, October 1st, at 10 A. M. at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton.

Burial will be at Parkwood Cemetery, Baltimore.
