



Linda "Jane" Saulsbury

June 3, 1938 - March 16, 2024

Beloved wife, mother, and grandmother Linda "Jane" Saulsbury passed away on March 16, 2024 in Easton, MD at the age of 85 with her daughter by her side. Jane was born on June 3, 1938, in Tulsa, OK to the late James B. Chiles and Dorothy J. Surber Chiles. She graduated from Auburn High School, class of 1956, and moved to Baltimore, MD. She continued her education at Towson State Teachers College where she met the love of her life, Milton F. Saulsbury. After graduating in 1961, she taught 8th grade English at Johnnycake Junior High School. Soon after, Milt received a fellowship to teach mathematics in East Africa. Jane joined Milt in Africa, making the journey on her own at the age of 23. Her description: "The equatorial heat was like a hot, heavy, wet blanket. The red clay road wound like a snake through dense rainforest and elephant grass that was alive with a myriad of sounds that I could not distinguish. That was my first impression as I disembarked from the "Usoga", a small lake cruiser that took me from Entebbe, Uganda to the Southern shores of Lake Victoria to Mwanza, Tanganyika".

After 18 months, they returned to the United States, in 1964. Her last place of residence was Centreville, Maryland, since 1975. She worked for the Town of Centreville from 1987 until her retirement in 2013. During her employment, she was awarded the Maryland Municipal Employee of the Year in 1998.

Jane enjoyed exercising, working in the yard, sewing, knitting, reading, the

beach, hazelnut iced coffee from McDonald's and spending time with her family.

Mrs. Saulsbury was predeceased by Milton, her husband of 36 years, her daughter, Suzanne J. Swensen and twin sister Susan C. Pillsbury. She is survived by her son, Steven M. Saulsbury (Cathy), daughter Laura B. Covey, both of Centreville, MD, her nine grandchildren; Matt, Dakota, Casey, Eric, Kelli, Emily, Jason, Josh and Nick and two great grandchildren. She is also survived by brother and sister-in-law, J. Stephen Chiles (Judy) of Akron, OH, cousin Thomas K. Cox, Jr, of Woodstock, MD and numerous nieces and nephews.

During her final years, Jane was in assisted living at Bayleigh Chase's Oakbridge Terrace. A heartfelt thank you to staff members Dot, Mark, NeeNee, Tyra and countless others for their loving care.
