



## Linda J. Deppe

May 14, 1944 - August 21, 2011

Linda Jane Deppe of Chester died on August 21, 2011. She was 67.

Born in Knoxville, Tennessee on May 14, 1944, she was the daughter of the late Howard Denton and L. Lorraine Moore Denton. After graduating from Catonsville Senior High School in 1962, she returned to Tennessee. She later returned to Maryland to work at the Hutzler's in downtown Baltimore. She then began a new career as a dental assistant. After time away from the work force to raise her family, Mrs. Deppe went to work as a bookkeeper for Contractors Systems, Inc. in 1980, a position from which she retired in 1992.
