



## Lisa Lynn Kemp

May 13, 1971 - January 29, 2021

Lisa Lynn Kemp of Easton, Maryland, passed away on January 29, 2021 at her home following a courageous battle with cancer. She was born on May 13, 1971, in Easton to Margaret Marie Kemp and the late Howard Wayne Kemp, Sr.

She graduated from Easton High School in 1990 and Chesapeake College in 2000. After graduating from Chesapeake College, she started her career at Easton Memorial Hospital as a CT Technologist and remained for 20 years until her illness.

Lisa enjoyed sports, especially ice hockey and softball -- the Washington Capitals being her favorite team. She played when she was in school with many lifelong friends. She also played softball with several teams and was looking forward to this past season, but illness prevented it. She had many friends that she played softball with and it was one of her favorite things to do in the summer.

She had a lifelong love of animals, even taking care of stray cats at the American Legion Post for many years. Her dogs and cats were her babies.

Lisa was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary Unit # 70, VFW Auxiliary # 5118, American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (R) (CT) – being

nationally registered in Radiology and CT, and American Society of Radiologic Technologists.

Lisa was predeceased by her brother, Howard Wayne Kemp, Jr.

She is survived by her mother, Margaret Kemp; niece, Megan Marie Kemp; sister-in-law, Tina Marie Kemp; lifelong friend, Marleen Barrett; along with many close family friends and her beloved dog, Bailey.

Graveside services will be held on Friday, February 5, at 12 noon at Spring Hill Cemetery.

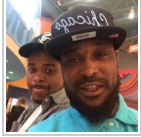
