



Lloyd Guild Allen

Born April 13, 1930, Lloyd G. Allen, of Kennedyville, MD, son of the late James H. Allen and Edna Webb Allen, died May 11, 2016.

In the year of 1965, the family moved from Mitchelville, MD, and bought the old Glenn L. Martin Farm. He met Lois R. Baldwin and was married on Dec. 30, 1970. In 1971, they moved to Kennedyville, MD. and built a home on Lloyd's farm.

Mr. Allen farmed all his life, while able, first at the farm in Mitchelville, MD, and later at "Green Oaks" farm as it was known. While farming, Mr. Allen was a true steward of the land utilizing farming techniques to protect and preserve the environment.

Mr. Allen was a United States Army veteran serving from 1955 until 1957. And was a member of the Betterton American Legion Post 246.

For many years, Mr. Allen enjoyed crabbing, fishing and hunting as well as cooking. He also enjoyed entertaining his family and friends.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Allen was predeceased by his wife, Lois Rodgers Allen in 2013. He is survived by his step-children, Ellen Mielke and husband Allan of Easton, MD; Bill Baldwin of Kennedyville, MD; and David

Baldwin of Chestertown, MD; Four-Step Grandchildren; and five step-grandchildren

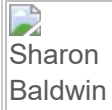

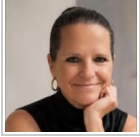
