



## Lloyd Acton Taylor

June 2, 1922 - March 7, 2018

Lloyd Acton Taylor, of Chestertown, MD, died on Wednesday, March 7, 2018 at University of Maryland Shore Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Chestertown. He was 95.

Born on June 2, 1922, in Washington, DC, he was the son of the late William Stanley and Mary Effie Acton Taylor. He graduated from Anacostia High School in Washington, DC, in 1940. Mr. Taylor worked for Jewel Tea Co. for a few years before going to work for Hearn Co. He was active in East Washington Heights Baptist Church for many years. Mr. Taylor was a lifelong Republican. He was always a huge baseball fan and a good family man.

He is survived by two sons, Dr. Lloyd Warren Taylor and Carol of Millington, MD, and the Reverend Wendell Martin Taylor of Burlington, CT; five grandchildren, Amy Taylor of Massey, MD, Heather Taylor of Chester, MD, Caitlin Taylor of Washington, DC, Kelsey Thompson and husband Brandon of Frederick, MD, and Leah Taylor of Washington, DC; and two great-grandchildren, Taylor Thren and McKenzie Thren both of Massey, MD. Mr. Taylor is also survived by a long-time, devoted caregiver, Amy Hayman, and her son, Logan.

He was preceded in death by his wife of 62 years, Anna Florence Taylor.

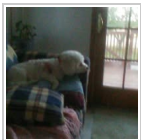
