



Lloyd E. White, Sr.

September 16, 1937 - November 2, 2008

Surrounded as he was in life by his loving family, friends, and food, Lloyd E. "Whitey" White, Sr. passed away peacefully at his home in Easton, MD on Sunday, November 2, 2008. He was 71.

Born September 16, 1937 in Annapolis, MD, he was the son of the late Arthur R. and Hilda Lindhardt White. Mr. White honorably served in the U.S. Navy for four years. For twenty-one years he was employed with the Maryland State Police as a polygraph examiner. He taught interview and interrogation to hundreds of recruits at the MD State Police Academy, founded the Hypnosis Unit for the MD State Police, and was Commander of the Polygraph Unit for four years. He was a graduate of the University of Maryland, where he earned a B.S. Degree in Psychology in 1977, and the Baxter School of Lie Detection. Following his retirement from the MD State Police in 1982, with the rank of Sergeant, he owned and operated his own polygraph business, Lloyd White Associates. From 1989 to 1999, he worked with the Anne Arundel County Police Dept. as a polygraph examiner and an associate instructor at the police academy.

A resident of Annapolis, MD, prior to moving to Easton in 2004, Mr. White was a life member of BPOE Annapolis Elks #622.

Mr. White is survived by his wife, the former Mary Susan Agnew, whom he

married March 18, 1959; two children, Sandra Jean Lerch and her husband Randy, and Lloyd E. White, Jr.; and six grandchildren. He was predeceased by a son, John Douglas White, who died in 1981.

Celebration of life calling hours will be held on Friday, November 7, 2008 from 6 to 8 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, MD.
