Lloyd Hilton Watts, Sr., of Philadelphia, formerly of Bruceville, died at his home on Friday, December 6, 2002. He was 94.

Born in Bruceville, January 6, 1908, he was the son of the late Joseph Ernest and Emma Corkran Watts. After attending public school, he moved to Philadelphia, PA in 1926 where, in 1933, he married the former Marie A. Quidas. For the majority of his working career, he was employed as a section manager in grocery stores including Rogers Brothers and Food Fair from which he retired in 1973. He had also worked in defense plants during World War II.

Surviving, in addition to his wife, are a son, Lloyd H. Watts, Jr. of Cincinnati, OH; a sister, Ellen W. Prettyman of Easton and two grandchildren. He was predeceased by two brothers, J. Milton Watts, his twin and Lynn Watts.

Funeral services will be held at the graveside at Jr. Order Cemetery, Preston, on Wednesday, December 11th, at 2:30 P.M.
