



Lois Rodgers Allen

July 31, 1924 - April 13, 2013

Mrs. Lois R. Allen of Kennedyville, MD, died in the Rock of Ages Care Home in Rock Hall, MD, on Saturday, April 13, 2013. She was 88.

Mrs. Allen was born July 31, 1924, in Mt. Carmel, PA, to the late William and Mae Metz Rodgers. She was a 1942 graduate of Mt. Carmel High School. In her high school years, she was very active in the yearbook staff, sports, the Glee club, drama club, masque & gavel, and the Quill and Scroll. She also served as business manager of the yearbook for two years. While in Mt. Carmel, she worked in Grossmans Department store, and while she was there, she received an appointment to the capital to serve as a legislative aide in Harrisburg, PA and worked there for six years.

In 1951, she moved to Kent County, MD, and worked for the Kent County Board of Education for 25 years. She worked her way through the system until attaining the position of Assistant Administrator to the Superintendent.

In 1970, she married Lloyd Allen, and they made their home on Green Oak Farm near Kennedyville, MD.

Mrs. Allen was a member of the First United Methodist Church, Chestertown, MD, where she sang in the choir and taught Sunday school for many years. She was also a former member of the Commission on Aging and retired from that position in 2009 after 15 years service.

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Allen is predeceased by a sister, Marion Mack.

She is survived by her husband of 42 years, Lloyd Allen; one daughter, Ellen Mielke and husband Allan of Easton, MD; two sons, Bill and his wife Susan Baldwin, and David Baldwin, both of Chestertown, MD; grandchildren, Monica Franceschini, Christopher Mielke, Jason Mielke, Julie Mielke, Charles Athey; five great-grandchildren; several nieces and nephews; and one brother, John W. Rodgers and his wife Olympia of Silver Spring, MD.
