Lois Virginia Baker died on Friday, March 22, 2019, at her home. She was 90.

She was born on December 3, 1928, in Harford County, MD, the daughter of the late James and Elsie Campbell O'Ferrall.

Lois graduated from Easton High School in 1945 and shortly after married J. Franklin Baker, Jr. They made their home in Trappe, MD. She was the postmaster of Trappe Post Office, retiring in 1999. 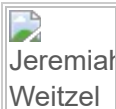
