



Lois M. Muntain

January 9, 1917 - April 2, 2013

Lois Mildred Muntain of Centreville, MD, died peacefully at her home, surrounded by her family, Tuesday, April 2, 2013. She was 96.

She was born January 9, 1917, in Salemville, PA, the eldest of four daughters of Charles P. and Mary B. Replogle.

She graduated from J. Leonard Replogle High School in 1935, and during World War II, she worked at Maryland Drydock as a timekeeper. It was there she met her husband, Charles Thomas Muntain. They were married March 8, 1946, and were married for 57 years until the death of Mr. Muntain in 2004.

“Miss Lois” worked as a doctor’s nurse for 31 years in Baltimore. When she and her husband retired, they moved from Crofton to Centreville in 1985. It was there that she began a second career working for the Queen Anne’s County Department of Aging as an escort driver, a position she held until she retired at age 90. She was selected as the Paratransit Driver of the Year in 1998.

She was a member of Mother of Sorrows Roman Catholic Church in Centreville and a volunteer at Hospice of Queen Anne’s.
