Lois A. Matson of Stevensville, MD passed away on Thursday, April 16, 2009 at the Mandrin Chesapeake Hospice House in Harwood, MD. She was 58 years old.

Lois was born on December 10, 1950 in New York City to the late Leonard Maartens and Pearl Smith. She grew up in North Babylon on Long Island and graduated from North Babylon High School, Class of 1968. She married her high school sweetheart and in 1987 they moved to the Eastern Shore.
