April 17, 1920 - September 8, 2011

Lois E. Hayman of Easton died at Genesis Health Care the Pines on Thursday, September 8, 2011. She was 91.

Born in Bristol, VA on April 17, 1920, she was the daughter of the late, Otha Plain and Mattie Lucinda Rhodes Young. After graduating from Bristol Virginia High School in 1938, she worked for the Philip Morris Company in Richmond as a cigarette inspector. She later moved to Memphis, TN where she worked as a bookkeeper for Memphis Photo Supply Company until her marriage in August of 1946 to Linwood G. Hayman.

After moving to Easton in 1947, Mrs. Hayman became a member of Trinity Episcopal Cathedral, where for many years she was active in the ECW and served as chair of the Altar Guild. Using her skills as a seamstress she made many altar hangings and vestments. She was devoted to her church and to her family. She was also a member and past Worthy Matron of the Order of the Eastern Star.

She is survived by a daughter, Cindy L. Orban of Easton; a son, Linwood G. Hayman II of San Diego; eight grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Linwood G. Hayman in January of 1994.

A funeral service will be held on Wednesday, September 14, 2011 at 1:00 pm at the Trinity Episcopal Cathedral in Easton. The family will receive friends

beginning at 12:00 pm.

Burial will be held at Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton.
