Lois J. Horney of Chester died on Tuesday, December 19, 2000 at her home. She was 72.

Born in Chester, MD on October 12, 1928, she was the daughter of the late Louis and Catherine Harris Jones. She graduated from Stevensville High School in the class of 1945. On October 5, 1945 she married Robert Horney of Grasonville. Mrs. Horney worked for the Acme Food store and Tidewater Bank in Stevensville, MD.
