



Lora Lucile Nowotne

September 3, 1922 - February 28, 2015

Lora Lucile Nowotne, 92, of Chestertown, MD, and West Dennis, MA, died peacefully on February 28, 2015.

Ms. Nowotne was born in Lewistown, MT. She was the daughter of Lucile Anderson and Herbert C. Chase. She is predeceased by her first husband, L. Judson Churchill, and her second husband, Edgar L. Nowotne. Ms. Nowotne received her education in Massachusetts. Before her children were born, she lived in New York City, working for Readers Digest. She also worked as an engineer for AT &T until the end of WWII, in Brockton, MA.

She and her family moved to Maryland in 1962. She worked for the Kent County Board of Education for a number of years before going to Queen Anne's County Board of Education, retiring in 1990. She was a member of the Maryland Retired Teachers Association, a member of Masona Chapter #34 of the Eastern Star, South Dennis MA, and a member of the Star Club. She has been a member of the USA Trotting Association. Ms. Nowotne worked as a volunteer with Hospice of Queen Anne's. She traveled all over the United States, Canada, and parts of Europe. After her retirement she spent each winter in Florida. She also had a home on Cape Cod, where she resided for a part of each summer. Many of her oil paintings hang in the homes of her decedents. In Florida, there are murals she painted on the outside walls of the vacation resort where she spent the winter months for visitors to enjoy.

She has three sons, Donald J. Churchill (Lucy Churchill), Stephen W. Churchill (Vera), and Mark E. Churchill (Beverly) Churchill. She leaves two grandsons, three granddaughters, three great-grandsons, and one great-granddaughter. Ms. Nowotne also leaves her extended family, William C. and Marjory F. Segal and their children of Atlanta, GA.
