Loring Earl Gingell of Easton died at William Hill Manor on Monday, September 23, 2002. He was 90.

Born in Rockville, Maryland on January 8, 1912 he was the son of the late James E. and Sadie Leizear Gingell. After graduating from Hyattsville High School, he attended the University of Maryland and received a BA Degree in 1934. Subsequent to graduation he joined the Federal Bureau of Investigation and also attended Southeastern Law School from 1938 to 1939. Following his tour of duty in the U.S. Navy from 1942 to 1946 he began a career as a Security Specialist for the office of Naval Intelligence at the Pentagon retiring in 1972. Formerly a resident of Silver Spring, MD., he and his wife, the former Elizabeth V. Ehle whom he married in June of 1935 moved to Easton in 1973. Mrs. Gingell died in 1987.

Mr. Gingell was a member of Christ Episcopal Church of Easton. In addition he was also a member of the Kappa Alpha Order and the Izaak Walton League. He was a former member of the Retired officers association, the Naval Intelligence Professionals and the Association of retired Naval Investigative Service Agents.

Mr. Gingell is survived by two sons; Robert L. Gingell, M.D. of Buffalo, NY., and James C. Gingell, D.D.S. of Annapolis, MD; one daughter Elizabeth G.

James of Annapolis, MD., 7 grandchildren and 9 great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at Christ Episcopal Church, Easton, on Friday, September 27, 2002 at 11:00AM. Burial will be at the Oxford Cemetery, Oxford, MD.
