Lorraine M. Florek of Chestertown, MD passed away on January 17, 2024. She was 83 years old.

Lorraine was born on August 11, 1940 in Philadelphia, PA to the late John H. Fitzi and Leona Schellinger Fitzi. She attended school in Philadelphia and began working in her father's bakery from a young age. On June 6, 1959, she married Vincent J. Florek and resided in Philadelphia before moving to Chestertown, MD in the early 1970s. They built a home in Chestertown, where she befriended many and cared for animals, including a special pet squirrel named Shirley. She will be remembered as a helpful, kind, and loving person. In addition to her parents and husband of 54 years, she was preceded in death by a sister, Marie Curtis, and brother, John Fitzi.

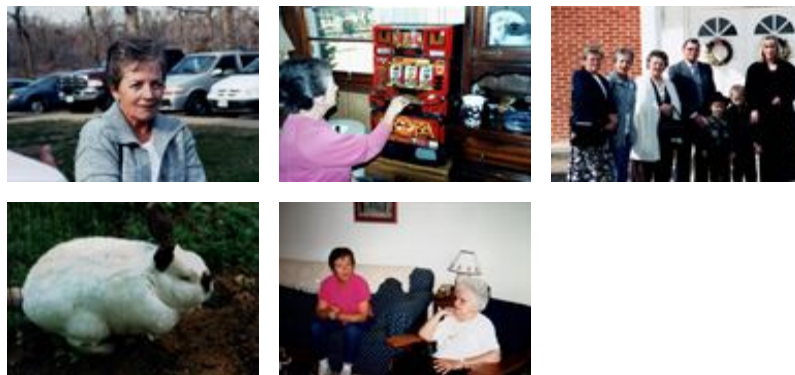
