



## Louis "Bud" Lawrence Stahl

August 7, 1930 - April 14, 2014

Louis Lawrence "Bud" Stahl died on April 14, 2014, at the UM Shore Medical Center in Easton, MD. He was 83.

Born in Baltimore, MD, on August 7, 1930, he was the son of the late Albert and Thersa (Eichert) Stahl. Bud graduated from Edison High School, Class of 1950. He married Leoma Bowser of Baltimore on November 14, 1953. He served four years in the U.S. Navy in the Atlantic during the Korean conflict. He worked as a steam fitter out of local #486 Baltimore until he retired in 1992. In 1987, he moved to the Eastern Shore. He liked building tugboats. His greatest love was his family and his country.

Mr. Stahl was a member of Kent Island United Methodist Church in Chester, MD, Centreville Lodge #180 AF & AM Masonic Lodge where he recently received his 50 year pin, American Legion post 297 of Baltimore, MD, and VFW #160 in Glen Burnie, MD.

Mr. Stahl is survived by his wife, Leoma Bowser Stahl; son, Barry Stahl (Kimberly) of Stevensville, MD; and granddaughter, Amanda. He was predeceased by his grandson, Daniel Stahl; brother, Albert Stahl; and sisters, Doris Happel and Hilda Wicks.

from 12-1 p.m. at Hidden Acres Farm, 27733 Burrisville Rd, Denton, MD, in the Carriage House.
