He graduated from Washington University with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Electrical Engineering. He was the Chairman of Sachs Properties, Inc. and the Chief Executive Officer of Sachs Holdings, Inc.

Mr. Sachs was a past board member of Barnes Jewish Hospital, Junior Achievement, Maryville University, Missouri Botanical Gardens, St. Louis Children's Hospital, St. Louis Council of Boy Scouts, St. Louis Symphony and the Washington University.
