Louise A. Biondo, a resident of Easton since 2000, died at Memorial Hospital at Easton on Monday, February 21, 2005. She was 79.

Born in Baltimore, March 6, 1925, she was the daughter of the late Oliver and Geneva Perrine. After graduating from high school, she worked as a telephone operator for C. & P. Telephone Co. During World War II, she worked for the Koppers Company as a part of the war effort. Following the war, she returned to work as an operator for C. & P. Telephone until retiring in 1984 after 40 years of service.

Prior to moving to Easton, she had lived in Baltimore where she was active with the Auxiliary of Knights of Columbus and Sultana with Alhambra. In her spare time, she enjoyed her family and working in her home.

Her husband, Joseph B. Biondo, whom she married May 24, 1944, died February 13, 2000.

Mrs. Biondo is survived by a son, Salvador F. Biondo and his wife, Karen, of Preston; a brother, Charles Perrine of Bradenton, FL; and two step-grandchildren, Stephanie Trumbauer and Eric Trumbauer, both of Glen Burnie.
