Louise Burgess Passano, of Easton, MD, formerly of Oxford, MD, died on Monday, September 17, 2001, at Heartfields in Easton, where she had resided for one year. She was 96.

Born in Pittsburgh, PA, December 6, 1904, she was the daughter of the late George H. and Harriet Van Trump Burgess. After graduating from Albany Girl's Academy in Albany, NY, she attended Wellesley College in Wellesley, MA, where she received her B.A. Degree in 1927. In October of 1929, she married Russell F. Passano, a chemical engineer, in New York City. They made their home in Middletown, OH, Bethlehem, PA, and New York City before moving to Oxford in 1970 where he died in 1973.

A member of The Church of the Holy Trinity in Oxford where she had served on the Vestry and the Altar Guild, she was also a member of the Harbor Club in Easton, the Tred Avon Yacht Club in Oxford, The Junior Auxiliary at Memorial Hospital, and the Wellesley Club of New York City.

Her children have said that a remarkable thing about their mother's life was her interest in people and the friendships she maintained over decades and generations – whether from school, her honeymoon trip to the Orient or the places where she lived and traveled. She maintained these friendships through correspondence and visits into her 90's.

Mrs. Passano is survived by a daughter, Lucia P. Powell of Cheshire, CT; a son, George B. Passano of Oxford; four grandchildren; and nine great-grandchildren. She was pre-deceased by two brothers, George V. T. Burgess of Scarsdale, NY, and Frederick Burgess of Milford, CT.

Memorial services will be held on Saturday, October 13, at 2 P.M. at The Church of the Holy Trinity, Oxford.

Inurnment was at the Columbarium of The Church of The Holy Trinity, Oxford.
