Anna Louise Hunter of Centreville, MD, died at the Talbot Hospice House, Easton, MD, on Tuesday, August 17, 2010. She was 94.

Born in Talbot County on October 13, 1915, she was the daughter of the late William O. and Margaret Helen Blades Callahan. She was the oldest of 11 children and grew up in Talbot County where she attended school. She married Thomas Hall Hunter on March 17, 1937. She was a homemaker and assisted her husband dairy farming at the “Hermitage” farm in Queenstown, MD, until 1973, when they retired and moved to Centreville, MD. Mr. Hunter died in 1999.

Louise was a devoted member of St. Joseph’s Catholic Church, Cordova, MD, St. Peters Catholic Church, Queenstown, MD, and Our Mother of Sorrows Catholic Church, Centreville, MD, where she actively participated with many of the church activities.
