



Louise P. Capute

February 9, 1925 - January 1, 2017

Easton: Louise Perkins Capute, age 91, died peacefully on Sunday, January 1, 2017, in Easton, MD, after a long illness. Born on February 9, 1925, in Norfolk, Virginia, Louise was the beloved wife of the late Dr. Arnold John Capute, a Professor of Pediatrics at Johns Hopkins University Medical School and founder of the field of Developmental Pediatrics. The couple met in Philadelphia, PA, while Louise was studying art at the Pennsylvania Academy of Fine Arts and Arnold was a student at Hahnemann Medical College. Louise and Arnold were married in 1949 and remained deeply devoted to one another in a marriage that continued for 54 years, until Arnold's death in November, 2004.

During that time, Louise continued to love painting, Junior League activities, cooking, raise four boys, and provide the loving devotion that allowed Arnold to excel in medicine.

Louise is survived by a sister, Ann Perkins Moore of Virginia Beach, VA; her four sons, Charles Thomas Capute of Trappe, MD, Arnold John Capute of Baltimore, MD, Allan Armistead Capute of Alexandria, VA, and Richard Claiborne Capute of Baltimore, MD; eight grandchildren; and one great-grandchild.

A private graveside service is planned.
