



Louise Quayle Kling

November 22, 1926 - November 24, 2014

Louise Quayle Kling of Centreville, MD, died on November 24, 2014. She was 88.

Born in Atlanta, GA, on November 22, 1926, she was the daughter of the late Osborne R. and Zaidee M. Quayle. She graduated from Druid Hills High School in Atlanta, GA, as a member of the Class of 1943, and then earned her Bachelor's degree from Vanderbilt University in Nashville, TN. On December 29, 1947, she married William Walter Kling of Lawrenceville, NJ, and together they owned and operated a farm in Queen Anne's County. Mrs. Kling began teaching at Centreville Elementary School, but spent most of her career at the Gunston School in Centreville, MD.

Mrs. Kling is survived by her loving husband of 66 years, William Walter Kling, Sr.; her children, Betsy K. Allen and her husband, Craig, of Huntsville, AL, William W. Kling, Jr. and his wife, Beth, of St. Louis, MO, and Martha K. Minor and her husband, Tom, of Dalton, GA; grandchildren: Kate Silvis, Craig Allen, James Kling, Emily Somerville, Lindsay Burgener and Kathy Sweetin; and seven great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her sister, Nancy R. Quayle.

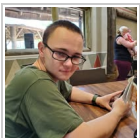
