A funeral liturgy for Louise M. O'Hara, of Easton, MD, and formerly of North Augusta, SC, will be celebrated at Sts Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Easton on Monday, November 18th at 11 A.M. Mrs. O'Hara died at the Wm. Hill Manor-Marvel Hall, in Easton on Thursday, November 14, 2002. She was 92.

Born in Pittsburgh, PA, August 29, 1910, she was one of four children of the late Mathias and Helen Krainak Eiben. After graduating from St. Veronica's High School in Ambridge, PA, and a business college there, she worked as a secretary for the Prudential Insurance Company in Ambridge. On April 10, 1931, she married James P. O'Hara, an engineer with the American Bridge Company who was later associated with E. I. duPont Co. During his career with duPont, they made their home in several locations throughout the United States.

Prior to moving to Easton, MD, in the mid-1980's, she had lived in North Augusta, SC, where she was a member of Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church. For 32 years she had been a Gray Lady for the Augusta, GA Chapter of the American Red Cross and had worked the majority of that time as a volunteer at the Veterans Administration Hospital in Augusta. After moving to Easton, she was a communicant of Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church and a member of the Women's Altar Guild of the church.

Mr. O'Hara died August 28, 1978, in North Augusta, SC.

Surviving, are three sons, James P. O'Hara, Jr. of Reston, VA, Thomas H. O'Hara of Easton, MD, and Gerald P. O'Hara of Downingtown, PA; fourteen grandchildren; and thirteen great-grandchildren. Another son, John J. O'Hara, is deceased.

Burial will be at the Pineview Memorial Gardens, North Augusta, on Wednesday, November 20.
