Louise Ann Lewis Marshall passed away peacefully on September 28, 2025, surrounded by her loving family who held her hand until the end.

Louise married Allen Franklin Lewis in 1949; they were happily married for 49 years. Together they had eight children: Linda, Gail, Elaine, Alvin, Allen, Marylou, Lisa, and Mark.
